



2006-2007 GOALS

Yolo County Board of Education

1. Discuss future directions of the Yolo County Office of Education and how the Board can help the organization be successful by exploring opportunities, as appropriate, for enhancement of services to our clients and benefits to our staff through regionalization and collaboration.
2. Solicit input from customers, community and other stakeholders in evaluating the performance of the Yolo County Office of Education.
3. Participate in the design and implementation of the YCOE Strategic Plan.
4. Work to achieve an understanding of each program's budget, e.g., revenue, expenditures, etc., which will lead to an overall deep knowledge of budget issues of the Yolo County Office of Education.
5. Request that managers annually present throughout the year, data on the progress in implementing program goals and plans for improvement.
6. Secure the necessary detail of information for effective governance of the Regional Occupation and the Court and Community Schools programs.
7. Engage in appropriate dialog with other county agencies regarding plans for the educational program at the new juvenile detention facility.
8. The Board recognizes the limitations placed upon it with reference to the governance structure of the SELPA, but also recognizes that the County Office of Education is charged with the responsibility of operating various special education programs. The Board of Education will actively promote innovation and excellence in each special education program for which the Office has responsibility. Active exploration of new models by interested Trustees and county office staff, and their adaptation to the populations served by the County Office of Education, will be encouraged.
9. Individual Board Members will visit various YCOE programs.
